

RULES FOR THE LA FLAMA AWARD

FEDERACIÓ DE JOVENTUTS MUSICALS DE CATALUNYA AND THE VIC QUARTET ACADEMY

In order to contribute to the promotion of new chamber music ensembles that appear in Catalonia and to help them along their professional path, Joventuts Musicals de Catalunya and the Vic Quartet Academy created the La Flama Award in 2023. This prize is awarded, for each of the categories, to the most promising chamber ensemble of the Academy, which is held in mid-July at L'Atlàntida de Vic, Osona's Performing Arts Centre. The award is aimed at stable chamber music ensembles with a minimum of two years' experience and at least one member who was born or musically trained in Catalonia. With the support of Gerard Claret and the Federació de Joventuts Musicals de Catalunya, the teachers of the Quartet Academy, Abel Tomàs and Gerhard Quartet, will each choose the ensemble with the best outlook and growth potential from among those participating in the Quartet Academy. The award will consist of a first presentation concert at the Petit Palau of the Palau de la Música Catalana and a tour as part of the Xarxa de Músiques de Catalunya [Musical Youth Network of Catalonia]. The organisation reserves the right to declare any award void. If this should happen, the jury may award two awards for the same category.
